• Raise parish awareness of development issues through our sale of Fair Trade goods as well as supporting the work of Trocaire.
• Provide practical support for small scale projects in developing countries.
Since we began we have supported a wide range of projects in Africa. We have an ongoing direct link with The Twezimbe Centre in Jinja, Uganda. This link came about through personal contact and knowledge of the validity of the project and that all money raised goes directly to the Centre. This Centre was pioneered by 2 Franciscan Missionary Sisters of Africa who have spent a lifetime doing missionary work in Africa. The Centre works with the people of Mbikko, an area of 14 villages and about 42,000 people. The generosity of Holy Family parishioners has enabled us to support a range of health and education programmes run by the Centre in order to empower the people with the knowledge and skills needed to sustain and further develop their own communities.
