FOURTH CORPORAL WORK OF MERCY

To welcome the stranger / to shelter the homeless

'The Son of Man has nowhere to lay his head'. [Matthew 8:20] Jesus was born in a borrowed manger, had no fixed address once he began his public ministry and was buried in another man's grave. It is quite an irony - the Son of God who created the universe became a homeless person. News coverage makes us aware of the plight of millions of refugees driven from their homes by war and famine and also of homelessness in our city and parish. As we grapple as a society and Church with the overarching challenge of homelessness this Corporal Work of Mercy encourages us to open our eyes to the misery of those who, for a variety of complex reasons, have no place they can call home; to give a hand up as well as a hand out. This Work of Mercy also invites us to ask ourselves how hospitable we are. The Letter to the Hebrews urges us: 'Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for thereby some have entertained angels unawares'. [Hebrews 13:2]. We affirm the tremendous work carried out by the members of our Ministry of Welcome, Hospitality Team, SVP, Newington Day Centre, Rosemount House, DePaul Trust alongside the day-to-day kindnesses shown by neighbours and friends. In short, this Work of Mercy can be summed up in the words of the Rule of St. Benedict: 'Let all guests be received like Christ'.
