SECOND SPIRITUAL WORK OF MERCY - TO INSTRUCT THE UNINFORMED

When Jesus saw the crowds following him, we are told 'He had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd; and he began to teach them many things' [Mark 6:34]. From his birth, and through all of his life, death and resurrection, Jesus teaches us the truth about God's infinite mercy and love. We are all called to keep learning from the life of Jesus, and then share what we have learned with others. During Pope Benedict's visit to England in 2010, he spoke with thousands of pupils and students, saying: 'We were made to know the God of love, the God who is Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and to find our supreme fulfilment in that Divine love that knows no beginning or end'. These words of Pope Benedict remind us that the great efforts made in our Catholic school communities, to make real the values of the Gospel, are wonderful examples of this work of mercy.

JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY PARISH EVENTS

The Parish is organising two forthcoming events to celebrate the Jubilee Year of Mercy proclaimed by Pope Francis:

Film: St Peter's and the Basilicas of Rome – 4 July 2016

This specially commissioned film to mark the Year of Mercy gives an exclusive visit to the 4 major Basilicas in Rome. Coach will leave from Holy Family at 4.30pm. Enjoy food and craic in Pizza Express, Dublin Road, before crossing to Movie House, Dublin Road for the film starting at 7.30pm. Return to Holy Family at 9pm. Anticipated cost £25 [subject to numbers]. A limited number of places are still available.

Lough Derg – Last few places available on this One Day Retreat: Sun 21 Aug 2016. Fr Paul Strain will lead the Holy Family Parish Retreat on Lough Derg. This is an opportunity to participate in a unique way in the Jubilee Year of Mercy. Depart from Holy Family Church at 7.30am, to arrive on the island in time for the Retreat to commence at 10.20am. Opening Prayers followed by Welcome, Way of the Cross, Prayer of Intercession and Gift of Mercy. Lunch will be followed by the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the Celebration of the Eucharist. Pilgrims will pass through the Holy Door at the Basilica to gain the special indulgence associated with the Year of Mercy. Refreshments will be served on arrival, with a light lunch of soup & sandwiches. We will depart from Lough Derg at 4pm, and travel home via Enniskillen, where we will enjoy dinner in the Killyhevin Hotel, arriving back to Holy Family at 9pm. Cost of the day, including Retreat, Travel and Food is £70.
