

Octopus for Preemie

Ever thought of becoming an Octopal by knitting or crocheting an octopus or a little hat for premature babies? Evidence suggests that the comfort of a sterilised knitted octopus may prevent babies from pulling out devices like monitors or tubes and create the feeling of being in the womb and so reduce stress of premature babies.
