The Lectionary

In its lectionary, the Church has collected certain Bible texts which best express the mystery of salvation within the liturgy. On most Sundays, the first reading is related to the gospel text, and gives it focus. This is not true, however, of the first reading on weekdays, nor of the second reading during the Sundays in Ordinary Time. These are passages from a single book of the Bible proclaimed day-by-day or Sunday-by-Sunday in biblical order. The responsorial psalm is related to the first reading. It is a proclamation of the word of God sung at the ambo. This proclamation is shared by the cantor, and the rest of the assembly. In the singing of the psalms, the risen Lord unites the voice of his body, the Church, with his own eternal hymn of praise. In the words of Psalm 122, "Let us go rejoicing to the house of the Lord."
