## Financial Statement for year ending 31st Dec. 2023

Dear parishioners of Holy Family Parish,

I would like to present to you the financial statement for the parish for the year ending 31st December 2023.

2022 was a challenging year for every family and household with the cost-of-living increases. Those challenges also affected our parish finances, and we recorded a significant loss at December 31st 2022.

I am glad to be able to report that our parish finances at the end of December 2023 were in a much healthier position. We have returned to an operating surplus position, and that was even before the inclusion of last year's Gift Aid figure. A statement of the Income & Expenditure figures for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2023 is presented in the following pages. Comparative figures for 2022 are also provided for comparison purposes.

The overall parish debt situation remains unchanged from that set out in the last financial report for 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022. The figure stands at £836,229.12.

Earlier this year the decision was taken to sell the parish properties on the Cavehill Road. The income generated from this sale should eliminate the Parish debt and will also remove a significant financial cost to the Parish of having to pay for the demolition of the old church. I have no update to provide at this stage on the timescale for the sale. Matters are now in the hands of the Parish solicitors.

Apart from keeping parishioners informed of the Parish financial position, it is also very important to take this opportunity to express gratitude to parishioners for your continued generosity. So, on that note, I would like to thank all those who have supported the Parish financially.

I would also like to thank all those who assist in any way in the financial administration of the parish. Thanks to those who organise and take up the collection at Masses. Thanks to the counting team volunteers. Thanks to all those who make the parish draw possible and so successful. Thanks to all those who made the Christmas Fair and the Antiques Fair events possible. Thanks are also owed to Nikki in the parish office and Raymond Noade for their work on the parish finances throughout the year. Finally, I would like to thank the members of the Parish Finance Committee for their time, ongoing work, and wise advice.

So, once again thank you everyone for your generosity and support to our parish.
